Dog Licensing Deadline Extended to February 14th – Mail in Applications Available

Lancaster, Ohio – Dog license season began in December, and the Auditor’s Office has made it easier than ever to license your pup! We’ve partnered with **DocuPet** to offer a quick and convenient way to apply online at **fairfield.docupet.com**.

The Fairfield County Commissioner have extended the registration deadline due to the recent inclement weather.

Ohio law requires all dogs over **three months old** to be licensed, and dog tags help lost pets find their way home.

Licenses are available for **one year, three years, or a lifetime**, and can be purchased:

- **Online**
- **At the Auditor’s Office**
- **At the Fairfield County Dog Shelter (Lancaster, open Saturdays)**
- **At the Clerk of Courts Title Office (Pickerington)**
- **By completing and mailing in the attached form (also found at <https://bit.ly/FCDogOfflineApp>)**

The deadline to license your dog has been extended to Saturday, February 14th.
